Hill Chapel


- · Capacity: 250

Housing

 Each group is assigned enough cabins to house your group. Your group can also reserve guest rooms for guest speakers, musicians, or other leaders. You will not be sharing cabins with other groups.

Cabins

We have 13 cabins holding 12, 14, 16, or 18 people. All
of these cabins have wooden frame bunk beds with
comfortable high quality mattresses. Each cabin has a
bathroom with a shower, two sinks and a toilet. The large
cabins have larger bathrooms. Bedding and towels are
not provided. Floor plans of each cabin are available online.

Guest Rooms

- We have 6 guest rooms that your group can reserve for speakers, musicians, and other leaders. Guest Rooms have a gueen bed and a bunk bed or a twin bed.
- Guest rooms are provided with bedding.

Meals

- Meals are served at set times of 8:15am, 12:15pm, 5:30pm.
- Well balanced meals which are usually staff-served buffet (exception: some family style for certain meals).
- We are also able to accommodate special diets for allergies and other medical conditions. A variety of menu choices are provided at every meal to accommodate non-meat diets.

Activities with an additional fee

These are activities provided by trained Phantom Ranch staff. Time slots can be reserved ahead of time as part of your retreat planning. Prices subject to change. Activities are subject to availability and weather permitting.

Archery/Tomahawk – \$25/hour. Instructor, equipment included.

Paintball – 100 paintballs for \$10. We play speedball in a fenced in field. Each player is provided with a mask and a quality Tippman brand paintball gun.

Horse Rides – \$20/ride. Horse rides are approximately 45 minutes. Includes an instructional time and a trail ride. Pony rides are available for children 8 and under.

Climbing – \$10/person. We have an indoor climbing center with 11 ropes, 20+ climbs, and 30 foot rock walls.

Team Building Course – Our staff can lead your group through team building courses. This activity focuses on team work, cooperation, and leadership development. \$8/person/hr.

Swimming and Boating – We can provide swimming and boating in our beautiful lake. \$50/hour.

Water Skiing – We can provide skiing, tubing and banana boat rides behind our new ski boat. Prices vary.

Wagon Rides - \$4/person. Minimum of 20 people.

Free Activities

Disc golf, basketball, softball, field games, hiking, gaga ball, dodgeball, teatherball, carpetball, board games, yard games, ping pong.

Free Winter Activities

Broomball, tubing, sledding, toboggan chute.
